

## PAKISTAN ON THE PATH OF NUCLEAR WAR AGAINST INDIA

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### **Abstract**

*With the end of British colonialism in the continent of Asia, a new conflict begins with resulted in the locked at the word peace in the region. This is the story of the conflict between two neighboring Nations known as the Indo-Pak conflict. Michael Bresser has written it right "India and Pakistan have always been in a state of undeclared war."*

*India and Pakistan being both children of the same Mother, despite both being their immediate neighbors, Pakistan continued to move away from India due to its anti-India and disruptive policies. At present, India and Pakistan are both nuclear-rich Nations. The destiny of Pakistan has always been a disruptive and separatist tendency against India. Hence there remains a gap in the relation between the two Nations especially with the current terrorist infiltration and the removal of 370 articles from Jammu and Kashmir; the relations between the two countries have become bitter. India has always been making sincere efforts to establish peace, friendship and co-operation with Pakistan. But Pakistan's attitude has been disruptive and violent since the time of independence. As a result, Pakistan has fought out four wars with India and has lost it (1948, 1965, 1971 and Kargil war 1999) if the conflict between the two Nations does not reduce in time, then there may be a nuclear war between India and Pakistan from the coming 2025. If there is a nuclear war between the two nations, more than 100 million people are expected to be killed. Fueled by the removal of Article 370 from Jammu and Kashmir Pakistan has openly threatened nuclear war against India. Every day from Prime minister Imran Khan to his minister, he is spreading such a nuclear war. Due to which there exist a war-like atmosphere between the two Nations.*

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## **Introduction**

### **Factual Analysis**

The background of India-Pakistan relations emotional attachment and indirect events is history. History testifies that relations between India and Pakistan have always been under stress due to historical and political issues. Particularly the root cause of this relationship in these two countries can be seen in the partition of India and the Kashmir dispute. Which to date has brought both countries to the threshold of nuclear war both countries have also taken military action on both sides regarding the Kashmir issue? Not only this, both countries have fought four wars So far. Pakistan has started them every time. Pakistan suffered a severe defeat in these four wars. To date, the political color of tense propaganda and accusations against each other in India and Pakistan is present whereas both countries are connected with the history, civilization, culture, geography and economy of a couple.

India and Pakistan despite being a child of the same mother, the nearest neighbor, Pakistan continued to move away from India due to its anti-India and disruptive policies. At present with the removal of Article 370 and 35A from Jammu and Kashmir and the continuous and propaganda terrorist activities by Pakistan, till date, not only bitterness in the relations between the two countries, but Pakistan is on the path of nuclear war. India has always been making sincere efforts to establish peace, friendship, and co-operation with Pakistan, but in the last few years, Pakistan has given a negative response. Pakistan responded to the Lahore bus trip and the Lahore Declaration made by the prime minister of India, Atal Bihari Vajpayee, as a Kargil incursion. Even after the Kargil conflict, Pakistan has continued to propagate anti-India support cross border terrorism. India's soft diplomacy on the international stage has exposed the real intentions of Pakistan to the international community. By the way, relations between India and Pakistan have been mostly against each other. It is clear from the statement of the Pakistan General and the Ministers and Prime Ministers against India that Pakistan has been transformed into a real Islamic country. Those who have nuclear strength General and Ministers including the Prime Minister of Pakistan, continue to threaten to use this atomic bomb against India. India has always suffered the wounds of terrorism to maintain relations with Pakistan. 1993 Mumbai blasts, attack on parliament in 2001, local trains exploded in Mumbai in 2006, The 2008 Mumbai massacre at the hands of terrorists, The Uri attack on 18 September 2016 in which 19 soldiers were Martyred in a terrorist attack on the local headquarters of the Indian army located near the LOC in Uri sector. The Uri Attack was avenged by India as a surgical strike. Incidents, The rulers of Pakistan told their people that a Muslim could outnumber 10 Hindus. Behind this incident, the army had

only one aim, that in their eyes peaceful relations with Pakistan's known enemy India could not be restored. While in the power of Pakistan Prime Minister Imran Khan, in February 2019, 40 Indian soldiers were killed in a terrorist attack on a CRPF convoy in Pulwama. India too, to avenge the disgusting act of Pakistan and the Martyrdom in Pulwama, Indian army aircraft made an airstrike on the terrorist bases in Balakot and demolished many terrorists and killed many terrorists. Therefore, India has once again given a strong message to Pakistan that the rulers of relations between the two countries have now changed.

Now every terrorist and infiltration will be given a befitting reply. In recent times, in childish Imran Khan keeps tweeting hateful tweets against the prime minister of India Narendra Modi. This has led to bitterness and deterioration in relations between the two countries. It is clear from this that the leaders and rulers of Pakistan including the Prime Minister of Pakistan have lost their way now they have only the path of religious frenzy. The world has become aware of the exploits and deeds of Pakistan on the international horizon and how isolated has Pakistan been around the world?

A report on New Delhi 04 Oct 2019, states that there may be a nuclear war between India and Pakistan between 2025 in which about 100 million people from both countries are feared dead. A US-based Rutgers University has predicted that India-Pakistan relations between the two countries will improve if there is a deterioration of nuclear war between the two countries. Research by Rutgers University which has conducted researcher on the state of war in different parts of the world and countries has prepared a report looking at the current tensions between India and Pakistan. The researchers who produced this report include people who have been part of several large our agencies. Therefore, the experts are taking this report seriously. From 2005, the strength of nuclear bombs will have increased even more with India and Pakistan Jung is not a child's play and no war is even fought with emotion. Complete preparations are made for rust. When the two countries are armed with Atom bombs face to face on the battlefield the danger increases a thousand times. At the pages of history, it seems that the world has not forgotten the nuclear attack on Japan. The US dropped only two bombs Japan's entire land was lost on Hiroshima (6 August 1945) and the other Nagasaki (9 August 1945) in Japan. For many months black smoke was seen in the sky of Japan. It is estimated that about two and a half million people were killed. This wear only official figures the actual number was much more than this. It took nearly 60 years for a developed country like Japan to stand up again after this ruin. For decades, the people of Japan have been battling a cancerous disease in the bedridden child due to the radiation. Staying

in Japan, earthquake keeps happening till today due to the fall of this devastating bomb. Currently, there are many modern atom bombs, missiles, tanks and powerful technical nuclear bombs between India and Pakistan. Both countries have several state-of-the-art aerial Warplanes. At present, both Nations have not more than one, but more than 300 nuclear bombs.

By 2025, the strength of nuclear bombs and modern weapons would have increased even more with India and Pakistan. Just think how terrible this war will be? With the withdrawal of Article 370 and 35A from Jammu and Kashmir and the continued infiltration from across the border, the way Pakistan is advancing, the world fears that a fierce nuclear war could erupt in both countries at any time. Apart from Pakistani leaders, Prime Minister Imran Khan himself has threatened nuclear war with India after the withdrawal of article 370 from Jammu and Kashmir. And this is also claimed in a report by a Rutgers University of America. This report claimed that there is a strong possibility of nuclear war between India and Pakistan. And if this nuclear war were to happen 100 million people would die in the world. According to the report because of the issue of Jammu and Kashmir, terrorists sitting in Pakistan can intensify the attack on the parliament in India. By 2025, this matter can go completely to extremes. India-Pakistan will retaliate, the capacity of which will be up to Pakistan-occupied Kashmir i.e. POK. This fight will be the cause of the biggest nuclear war in both countries. A study by Rutgers University says that India and Pakistan currently have about 150 to 200 nuclear weapons; but from the coming 2025, its number can be from 400 to 500 and civilians of both the nation will have a lot of devastation in their lives and it will also have a bad effect on nature. From the number of nuclear weapons that India and Pakistan have, it can be estimated that between 16 and 36 tons of black carbon will be open due to nuclear war because of which the radiation from the sun will be blocked and the light from the sun to the earth will be reduced by 20 to 35 percent. Due to the occurrence and fall of this nuclear war, the earth will be called from two to five degrees Celsius and this will have an impact on the weather around the world. Temperatures will fall so much that small areas will turn into ice ages. This will also weaken the fertility of the land at the same time there will be a fall in rain. Ultraviolet radiation will also reduce the Ozone (O<sub>3</sub>) layer due to colder temperatures and less sunlight.

Alan Robok who wrote the report says due to the prevailing atmosphere of tension over the issue of Jammu and Kashmir and soldiers are being killed every month across the border, it is only because of this that the war can reach the climax of nuclear war. If these nuclear weapons were used in the event of war on both sides, their off would be disastrous for the global environment. Scientists have reported

in the report that if nuclear war takes place between India and Pakistan, it may take more than a decade for the world to recover from the consequences.

### **Conclusion**

From the observation and analysis of the above facts, the conclusion can be said that India and Pakistan are both nuclear-rich nations in the continent of Asia. As the two Nations have developed a story of antitrust tense, conflict, politics, hostility, full-blown, accusations both of them degrade each other on the international stage. Certainly, a Rutgers University of America report started on 04 October 2019 that the prediction and anticipation of nuclear war between India and Pakistan by 2025 are visible. In the current situation, Pakistan is strategizing against India by joining hands with China and joining hands with Muslim Nations like Turkey. In the war between Azerbaijan and Turkey, they are providing their army and weapons and together with China, conspiring against India on LOC and LAC. Surely in the coming times, there can be a conclave of nuclear war between the two Nations at any time. On several forums, with Turkey drawing 370 articles from Jammu and Kashmir supporting Pakistan on the Kashmir issue, Pakistan is selling land to China to build a military base on its land, terrorism from across the border is conspiring against India. Ammunition is being fired at the border at any time and at any time. Due to this, there is a fear and apprehension between the two Nations that at any time Pakistan can make a policy of war. Because history is also a witness that Pakistan has waged war against India for the first time in 4 wars. According to this report published in Science Advance, if there is a situation of nuclear war between India and Pakistan, then both nations may have to suffer a lot of damage. Millions, crores soldiers and the public will be killed from both sides. Not only this after the nuclear explosion, but carbon in the atmosphere will also collect a large amount of solar radiation. This will cause heat in the air. This will cause a fall of 20 to 25 percent in the sun. The heat will dry up the land the farming will be completely ruined. This will also several impacts on vegetation development and ocean productivity. It may take years for the world to recover from this. Not only India and Pakistan will be affected by this nuclear war but many countries of the world have been affected by carbon emissions in the country.

Therefore, in time, India and Pakistan should leave the politics and jihad mentality of their stressful struggle and start on the path of peace and development. Strengthen relations on a bilateral basis in the interests of the citizens and soldiers of both nations. To date, no problem has been solved in the world by war. War leads to destruction.
